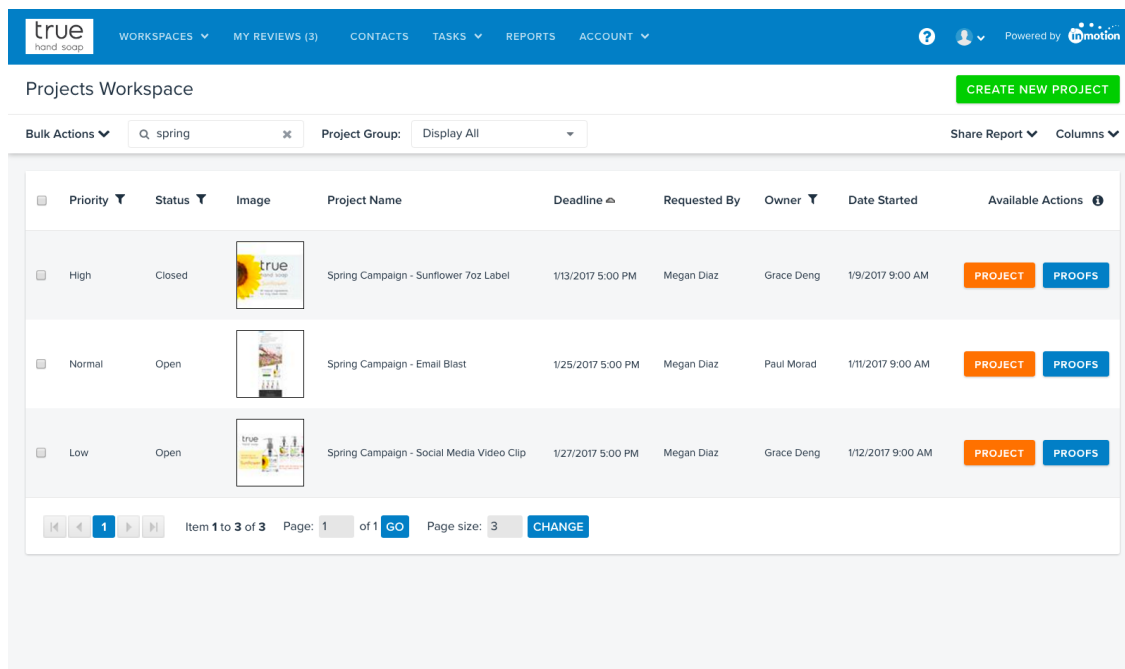


Persistent Search




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During each login session, persistent search means that any search query will remain applied in the workspace unless it is cleared. For example, if you perform a search similar to the example below, navigate to another page, then return, the same search filter will still apply to the applicable workspace.

To clear your search, click the X to the right of your custom text within the search bar.
