



Receiving an I/O Error When Uploading a Proof

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An I/O error usually means that a setting on your machine or local network is blocking access to our converters. If you need to upload the proof immediately, start by trying a different browser to see if that resolves the issue.

Ultimately, you may need to consult with your IT team to see if your company is using a proxy or an anti-virus software. Once that's been confirmed, send a request to have these two domains whitelisted by your IT department:

`convert.inmotionnow.com`

`api.inmotionnow.com`

This should solve the issue permanently, but if not, please reach out to support.
